## WOMEN'S NATIONAL TEAM COACHES

Deaf Basketball Australia, in conjunction with Basketball Australia, is seeking the services of a suitably qualified coach for the positions of Head Coach and Assistant Coach for the Women's (Geckos) National Program.

The Head Coach will provide overall leadership of the team's program with the objective of achieving a high level of performance at the 2009 Deaflympics in Taipei while the assistant Coach will add to the learning experience of the players and support the Head Coaches program.

**HEAD COACH:** The successful applicant will need to establish a strategic plan for the team that is in keeping with the overall vision of Deaf Basketball Australia and take responsibility for the overall development and management of the National Team

**Requirements:** Demonstrated coaching success and international experience together with leadership and program management skills.

**ASSISTANT COACH:** The successful applicant will need to demonstrate a record of coaching and team oriented focus with an ability to help others achieve their goals.

The roles are not full time allowing the successful applicants to continue in their paid positions. The bulk of the team's activities will take place in the April – September period next year. The extent of the time commitment will be finalised after discussions with the successful applicants.
